Important Information:

- Cost shares for covered insulin products will not be more than a \$35 copayment for a 30-day supply regardless of the tier. Additionally, the Part D deductible will not apply to any covered insulin products.
- Starting January 1, 2025, Lantus[®] will be moving off-formulary, however, Basaglar[®] and Toujeo[®] will continue to be covered long-acting alternatives.
- Your provider can write a prescription for you for any of these covered insulin products. In some cases, your pharmacist can switch them automatically.

You'll pay a \$0 copay for these items when you fill them at an in-network pharmacy. **Keep reading for how you can get a coupon to receive a LifeScan ONETOUCH or Roche Accu-Chek meter at no cost to you.**

When you fill your diabetic testing supplies and CGMs through a durable medical equipment (DME) provider, you'll pay more. The cost is 20% coinsurance at a DME provider instead of a \$0 copay if you get the same supplies and CGMs at an in-network pharmacy.

Important!

If you use diabetic testing supplies and/or a CGM that is not preferred by our plan, talk with your provider to get a new prescription for preferred items or to request an exception for non-preferred items.
